## EVERY DAY COUNTS



Help your child achieve their true potential by ensuring they attend school regularly!

Did you know that every single day a pupil is absent from school it equates to a day lost learning.

At times percentage figures can be misleading therefore to offer you more clarity I have broken them down:

<b>100% attendance</b>	<b>0 days missed</b>	<b>Excellent</b>
<b>95% attendance</b>	<b>9 Days of Absence 1 week and 4 days of learning missed</b>	<b>Satisfactory</b>
<b>90% attendance</b>	<b>19 Days of absence 3 weeks and 4 days of learning missed</b>	<b>Poor</b>
<b>85% attendance</b>	<b>28 Days of Absence 5 weeks and 3 days of learning missed</b>	<b>Very poor</b>
<b>80% attendance</b>	<b>38 days of absence 7 weeks and 3 days of learning missed</b>	<b>Unacceptable</b>
<b>75% attendance</b>	<b>46 days of absence 9 weeks and 1 day of learning missed</b>	<b>Unacceptable</b>
